Coolamatong run two different campsites, meaning you'll get to build relationships with a wide range of kids from Grade 3 – Year 11. You'll mentor kids from a diverse range of backgrounds, while experiencing camping in its many different forms.

Our Farm Campsite has cabin and bunkroom style accommodation. Camps have short activities and small groups rotating through each activity.

Our Lake Campsite is suited to older students, with unique 'Tebin" accommodation and longer activities including overnight hikes.

MINISTRY IN THE OUTDOORS

At Coolamatong, we are committed to sharing the reality of God in relevant and meaningful ways. This could be through revealing the wonder of creation, sharing a personal story, leading a discussion or activity, or just chatting with kids over a meal. Coolamatong's heart is about building relationships and planting seeds that we pray will be <u>eternally significant moments in a camper's life.</u>



Interns are provided with furnished accommodation (your own bedroom in a share house) and this includes all utilities and internet access. Most meals are also provided. A shared intern car is available at a small cost for interns who hold their drivers license but do not have a vehicle of their own. Outstanding! The interns were a lovely group of young leaders, full of enthusiasm and proved to be great mentors for our students. Even during free time sessions, they were eager to participate in games or simply chat with students, which they loved.

QUALIFICATIONS AND TRAINING

An internship at Coolamatong will provide the opportunity to:

A) deepen and grow your faith as you are discipled and mentored

B) gain nationally recognised Cert IV qualifications in Outdoor Recreation or Cert III qualifications in Christian Ministry and Theology

C) gain qualifications in First Aid and Life Saving Victoria Bronze Medallion

D) develop leadership skills, experience and training in children and youth ministry



LIFE SKILLS

A big part of the internship is living away from home. Living and working in community provides the opportunity to develop the skills that will equip you for years to come. Living on site among Coolamatong residential staff and their families as well as with other interns helps to foster a sense of community. Interns are also encouraged to build a team of people who are willing to partner with them during their internship to prayerfully, practically and financially support them during this time.

NORTHERN TERRITORY MISSION TRIP

Every July, a team of staff and interns fly to the Northern Territory to learn from and assist Scripture Union Northern Territory and to enjoy a different experience of being on mission with God. The trip includes training in cross-cultural ministry, assisting with an indigenous youth program and visiting indigenous communities near Katherine. Trip fundraising happens during the year.
